

# CONTINUING MEDICAL EDUCATION (CME)



AAFP Cat 1 – up to 14.50 CME hours



ABPM – up to 14 Maintenance of Certification (MOC) hours



AMA PRA Cat 1 for physicians (FAA) – up to 14.50 CME hours



FAA Credit for HIMS AME Periodic Training (required every 3 years)

\* In addition to the FAA AME Refresher Training requirements, attendance *to entire seminar and a passing test grade are required*

Mental Health Professionals – up to 9 Professional Development Hours (PDH)  
Attendees will receive a Certificate of Completion to submit to their respective agencies for Professional Development Hours.



Psychologists – up to 14 Continuing Education (CE) hours

The American College of Professional Neuropsychology is approved by the American Psychological Association to sponsor continuing education for Psychologists. The American College of Professional Neuropsychology maintains responsibility for this program and its content.

14 Continuing Education credits (CE) will be offered during the 2½ day 2018 HIMS Basic Education Seminar. CE for psychologists will be awarded only to those participants who attend all of the CE programs offered each day to psychologists.

Participants must sign-in at the beginning and sign-out at the end of each day on those days they attend the CE approved presentations. A certificate of attendance will be distributed at the end of each day for each day's presentations.
